**CHANGE:HEALTHCARE LAUNCHES NEW USER SITE;
GREATLY INCREASES OFFERINGS TO CONSUMERS, CUSTOMERS**

NASHVILLE, Tenn., (March 3, 2008) – change:healthcare, a Nashville, TN-based healthcare technology company, today launched a new interface to boost the amount and variety of information and services available to its users. Included in the upgrade is the company's signature medical bill manager product, previously called MedBillManager, which helps subscribers better organize and manage their medically related invoices, insurance explanation of benefits and paperwork.

“This new site significantly broadens the healthcare information tools available to consumers and should continue ushering in far more transparency to the healthcare arena,” company co-founder and CEO Christopher Parks said at a Monday event marking the launch. “We’re hopeful this change will make accessing critical healthcare and financial information even easier for consumers so they can make far more informed decisions about their own and their family’s medical care.”

All services and products of the company will also now be branded under the change:healthcare banner.

The site will include new information channels to help consumers explore a wide variety of health issues, as well as better compare the cost and performance of local and national healthcare providers, insurers, even prescriptions.

change:healthcare was launched in 2006 after the cancer deaths of Parks’ parents left the Nashville healthcare executive trying to decipher the insurance EOBs, invoices and paperwork of their last days of care. Unable to gain a clear handle on the reams of paper, Parks united several programmers from both the United States and Denmark to develop what

became MedBillManager. The product, which will change its name in the new user interface simply to “bill management,” has been available to consumers, third party administrators, healthcare providers and medical bill adjudicators. It recently has also seen increased use among employers implementing high premium health plans like HSAs to provide both company and employees a tool to better track healthcare expenditures and when a company’s premium match should kick in.

Members of the Nashville healthcare and business communities, some of whom collaborate with the company and/or are customers of the product, gathered for the announcement. Because of a shared interest in the company’s social thrust, representatives of the emerging Web 2.0 consumerism industry were also in attendance. The site has become a portal for users to anonymously share healthcare information to reduce healthcare expenditures and bring greater transparency into the industry.

“We’re hopeful users will make significant use of the new channels of information that accompany the broadening of our interface,” Parks continued. “We want to better engage consumers and employers in making more informed healthcare decisions for themselves, their employees and their families. That alone can help us improve the American healthcare system.”
