TESSERA SOLAR STATEMENT ON CALIFORNIA ENERGY COMMISSION FINAL DECISION ON CALICO SOLAR PROJECT

At its December 1 California Energy Commission (CEC) business meeting, the CEC corrected clerical errors with the issuance of its October 28 Final Decision for the Calico Solar Project, making the approval effective on December 1. The stay of the effective date ordered by the Chairman on November 19 was vacated, and the Executive Director withdrew and re-filed the Notice of Decision on December 1. Tessera Solar appreciates the CEC's action to clear the clerical errors regarding its approval of the Calico Solar Project.

The 663.5 MW Calico Solar Project is located on 4,613 acres in San Bernardino County, 37 miles east of Barstow, California. Tessera Solar has a 20-year Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with Southern California Edison for the Calico Solar Project. Solar power generated from the Project will assist the State of California in meeting its goal of reducing greenhouse gas emissions and achieving its Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) requirement.
